



ERIE COUNTY COMMUNITY FOUNDATION 2023 COMMUNITY LINKS SUMMER INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

The Erie County Community Foundation's Summer Internship Program offers undergraduates, recent graduates, and graduate students the opportunity to intern for 10 weeks, **May/June through August 2023**, in an Erie County nonprofit organization or governmental agency. Organizations that have received Foundation grants will host the interns, who will be paid \$15.00 per hour for 40 hours per week.

PROGRAM OBJECTIVES

- Offer undergraduates, graduate students, or recent graduates first-hand knowledge of the Erie County nonprofit community, its leadership, and organizations
- Provide meaningful career-related work experience
- Increase local organizations' capacity to conduct important short-term projects
- Stimulate interest in a career in the nonprofit or public sector
- Expose interns to a broad range of public sector endeavors

WHAT INTERNS CAN EXPECT

- **Clear goals:** Interns will receive a detailed description of the specific projects or activities they will be expected to accomplish during the internship period
- **Clear direction:** Each host organization will designate a senior staff member to supervise the intern's work
- **Summer Work Schedule:** Each intern will work the full 10-week period with no vacation or time off scheduled.

HOW INTERNS ARE CHOSEN

A selection committee comprised of several members of various Erie County organizations and private foundation members review applications and match interns and sites according to qualifications and interests of the interns and needs of the organizations.

QUALIFICATIONS

Applicants must meet the following qualifications:

- Be a college sophomore, junior, senior, or graduate student in Fall 2023, or a recent college graduate
- Have a declared major
- Exhibit interest in the nonprofit or public sectors
- Applicant must be a resident of Erie County, Ohio
- Must be able to pass a BCI background check
- Must have own transportation.
- Be available to complete the full term of the continuous 10-week internship with no vacation or time off.
- Any student serving as a Community Links Summer Intern in prior years is ineligible to apply for one year.

Other highly desirable qualifications include:

- A strong academic record (**a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or above is recommended**)
- Strong verbal and written communications skills

APPLYING FOR THE INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

To apply for the Erie County Community Foundation's Community Links Internship Program, please complete the attached application form and include:

- Your resume with two letters of recommendation.
- The most recent transcript of your completed college (or graduate school) coursework.
- A typed (double-spaced) essay. Please discuss your interest in the nonprofit or public sector, why you are applying for the summer internship program, your previous work and volunteer experiences, college level awards and honors, and your plans for the future.
